

# Christmas

## Did the Most High command us to celebrate Christmas?

No! Read **Jeremiah 10:2**, “*Thus saith the Lord, learn not the way of the heathen, and be not dismayed at the signs of heaven; for the heathen are dismayed at them.*”

**Jeremiah 10:3**, “*For the customs of the people are vain: for one cutteth a tree out of the forest (the Christmas tree), the work of the hands of the workman, with the axe.*”

**Jeremiah 10:4**, “*They deck it with silver and with gold (Christmas ornaments); they fasten it with nails and with hammers, that it move not.*”

## Why do our people celebrate Christmas?

In **Matthew 15:9** says, “*...in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.*” The so-called Blacks and Hispanics (the Israelites) celebrate this pagan holiday because their religious leaders have lied them to. **Isaiah 9:16** says, “*for the leaders of this people cause them to err; and they that are led of them are destroyed.*”

They have been taught that Christmas is the birthday of Jesus Christ, which is a lie! The Bible does not state the date of Jesus birth. Furthermore, the custom of bringing trees into your houses and decorating them (**Jeremiah 10:1-5**) occurred long before Jesus was born. Therefore, what have you been celebrating? Certainly, not the birth of Jesus Christ; Christmas stems from an idolatrous custom of the ancient Babylonians. This goes against Gods’ commandments written in **Exodus 20:3-7**.

## Will the Most High and Christ judge you for celebrating Christmas?

Yes! Read **II Thessalonians 1:8**, “*In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel our Lord Jesus Christ:*”

**II Thessalonians 2:12**, “*That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.*”

**2 Corinthians 5:10**, “*For we must all appear before the judgement seat of Christ; that everyone may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done ,whether it be good or bad.*”

Also read **Revelation 22:14**, “*Blessed are they that do his commandments...*”
