Leviticus 26:40 "If they shall confess their iniquity [sin], and the iniquity of their fathers, with their trespass which they trespassed against me, and that also they have walked contrary unto me;" Verse 41: "And that I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity: "Verse 42: "Then will I remember my covenant [agreement of mercy] with Jacob [father of the nation of Israel], and also my covenant with Isaac, and also my covenant with Abraham will I remember; and I will remember the land."

Our fathers brought us up in ignorance, in religions and traditions that are sinful, not knowing that we are descendants of Israel with blessings that await us. Acts 5:31 "Him [Christ] hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins." For this reason we must bethink ourselves and confess (renounce) the sins of our fathers that we may receive by our repentance, forgiveness of our sins and of his good promise.
