

The word **fallowe**'en is an abbreviation of Hallow even, meaning holy night; the name itself shows this is a "religious day". To our dismay, many observe this day without researching the historical meaning or the scriptures for guidance. You should ask yourself, what's holy about it? Did God sanctify or blessed this day to make it holy? 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 10:20 "But I say, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God: and I would not that ye should have fellowship with devils." Verse 21: "Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils." Verse 22: "Do we provoke the Lord to jealousy? are we stronger than he?" Anyone could see that Halloween is obviously rooted in paganism (worshiping of false gods/devils and witchcraft).

## Trick or Treat?

You have been tricked into worshiping Satan! The origins of Halloween could be traced back as a "religious day" of the Celtics, with the celebration of the Festival of Samhain (day of the dead and of evil spirits). Today it is considered the New Year for Wiccans (witches). Amazingly the evil roots of sacrificing to the dead, as in Day of Dead in Mexico, and the Catholic holiday All Saints Day (Allhallows) go further back than the Celtics and it could be found in the Bible. **Psalms 106:28** "*They joined themselves also unto <u>Baal-peor</u> [false god], <u>and ate the sacrifices of the dead</u>." Verse 29: "<i>Thus they provoked him* [God] *to anger with their inventions: and the plague brake in upon them*." Observing a "holy night" that God didn't sanctify angers him and will cause destruction to brake upon you if you participate in Halloween.

## Evil is Good?

Some dismiss the Scriptures and say, "it is a day to have fun, to get candy, dress up in costumes, to have frightening stuff, and to scare people with it; that is why I enjoy this holiday". **Proverbs 16:25** "*There is a way that seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.*" So you plan to knock on doors to ask for candy? **Isaiah 5:20** "*Woe* [DESTRUCTION!] *unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bit-ter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!*" On this day people give **sweet** candy to children for the **bit-terness** of sin. **1**<sup>st</sup> **Corinthians 13:6** "*Rejoiceth not in iniquity* [sin/evil], *but rejoiceth in the truth;*" You might not realize that you are glorifying evil and the influence it could have on your children. The horrible customs of Druid priests of dressing up and knocking on doors asking for an offering will prevent you from entering the kingdom of God. See, **Ephesians 5:10-11, Gala-tians 5:19-21**, and **1**<sup>st</sup> **Peters 4:2-6**. You can't have two masters, so then who are you going to worship, God or the Devil?
